## The Body of Christ - Love and Understanding - The Story of Kim Su San.

Maccello: God bless you.

All: God bless you Maccello.

**Maccello:** It is so long since first we met and in these times when we have sat together and talked we have had many causes to search one another's thinking and to know one another's hearts and we have looked among you having listened to the things that you have said and the way you have said and believed in them and we have come to the knowledge that all is well and all is as it should be and there will come those among you who will bring a fortification of the process upon which you have embarked and will bring a new light and a new way again of thinking, they will have also their own conceptions concerning the way they believe and have seen for themselves life here on Earth and their comparisons with those of the teachings which you are searching so lovingly to find.

These are not spiritual beings I am talking of, these are material beings, one by one they will come and they will go but you will remain and you will continue to unfold with Maccello and Brother Gustus Emmanuel a new understanding of the word of God and how it applies to your life today. Why am I saying this, perhaps you are thinking well we knew this already, but I want to say this to you to point out to you that you have in the way you have worked and progressed and persevered and remained stalwart to those things which you know in your hearts and feel to be right. Is this not a true example of the one word you have come to speak with Maccello of tonight; is this not a true example of the faith? You are a light unto yourselves and as your faith grows so you also will grow and you will expand and you will proclaim those many things you seek to do and as you seek to do these things you will feel in your hearts, but there are always obstacles to be put in our pathway and just when we think we are about to progress there comes another obstacle.

Have we not talked to you of the importance of creating within you heart a dream, an ideal, a belief, based upon your faith, just as a sculptor would do and are you not in the process of carving for yourselves a fulfilment of this beautiful dream and ideal you have, all centred and strengthened and supported by your faith. It may be Brother John that I have already answered perhaps one of your questions but I will listen to it just the same, I will give you the opportunity to talk with Maccello but please hold in your hearts, each and every one of you, there is no one senior to another, you are all on the same level of understanding according to your state of progression at this moment and you are therefore in our eyes equal and you are equal in the sight of God but it is by his wish that we ordained Brother John the task of communication because of his standing in life and his calling to the Holy cloth and the Holy orders of his profession and of his belief and of his way of life to which he was called. You understand this Brother John?

## Brother John: Yes indeed, thank you.

*Maccello:* And does everyone else understand this and you are content in your hearts that this is so? So let us now, knowing that we have demonstrated to ourselves the strength of faith and the fulfilment of purpose born of that strength of faith, let us go forward now and see if we can together unfold those things you seek to understand. So Brother John, talk with Maccello.

**Brother John:** Thank you for those thoughts Maccello on faith, and if you've no more to add to that then I will go on to perhaps the main question, perhaps Gustus Emmanuel would like to talk about this. What is meant by Christians when they use the phrase, we are the bodies of Christ?

*Maccello:* Brother John in days gone by and again in your early days, in the times before Maccello, many of these phrases were used, they were used to imprint into the minds of people the importance and the need for them to understand the spirit of Christ. And you see, those of his children who believed in him and who loved him so much and wanted so much to be a part of him and all he believed, of all he did, wanted to work with one accord, one faith you say in your prayers, one hope, one God and you see this one faith this one hope this one God was brought to the understanding of man through the love of Christ through his dedication to mankind and to his service to God. And he looked upon this collectively as a body, a body of beings, a body of love, loving souls, both here on this Earth and in the next. And his disciples saw this and understood this and spoke to the masses when they talked of the body of Christ, by this they meant the whole mass of those who believed as one body, as one being, as one thought, as one hope one faith, all in one God.

This was the beginning of these phrases, but where did this really originate, what planted this into the minds of those of his disciples, and surely Brother John the answer for you here is so simple. It was born in their minds at the last supper when God through Christ spoke of this body, this is my body, this is my son, this is my blood, this is my cause, a whole body of causes and purposes and events moulded into one faith, one belief, the way of Christ and so his disciples look upon it as the body of Christ. Take eat for this is my body and this they did. And are they not saying it to you now, is not Maccello saying it to you now, take this love, make it a part of you, digest it, for it is the love of Christ, it is the body of Christ, it is the body of his being, the body of his faith, the body of his truth, the body of his love, the body of his eternal trust in God, an immovable dedication to the purpose of God on Earth. And so all these aspects are brought together in the words of the disciples and the prophets as one body, the body of Christ. And so this belief has been handed down, sometimes it may have been misconstrued, a little misunderstood and used sometimes more as a phenomena than a faith and a truth, but the whole conception of this was born in the minds of those of his disciples in the evening of the last supper. Do you understand this Brother John?

*Brother John:* Yes, that's the simplest explanation I have been given Maccello, it is very beautiful, and we thank you.

*Maccello:* We live and we breathe and we exist and we progress in the body of Christ simply because of our faith, so you see Brother John, your questions are all intermingled.

Brother John: Yes, very nice indeed, thank you Maccello.

Maccello: Is any more you wish to talk with me on now?

Brother John: I think we've asked you all the questions Maccello.

Maccello: Would you wish me to talk with you on a topic of your choosing?

Brother John: Well I've given you my two and I thank you for those Maccello.

*Maccello:* Who else will wish for a topic of their choosing? So silence is wisdom.

Brother Christopher: What is love and understanding?

*Maccello:* Christopher you have not been standing as still as you have thought, you have been moving very gently like a ship across the oceans, it does not paddle itself but is propelled by an inner power and you also my child are propelled by an inner power. Tell me once again what is your question Christopher?

Brother Christopher: How would you describe love and understanding?

*Maccello:* Love. What is love, love takes so many forms it is in so many things, but love to Maccello is a total unquestioning acceptance of all things around you, without fear, without question, it is an acceptance of all those things which are pleasing to the spirit and with which the spirit can become one. You understand this Christopher?

Brother Christopher: I understand what you are saying.

*Maccello:* So you see, love is a true expression of the spirit within, a simple answer. It is the true expression of the God power within man, it is the true expression of his acceptance of his fellow beings, of his fellow creatures, of the need for those around him to be understood and it is his strength to understand, it is from his love, from the expression of his spirit, where he finds the strength to understand and to accept and to forgive and to have compassion and to have all these things which are gifts of the spirit. Was it not said, of faith and hope and charity that the greatest of these is charity and charity is love? You understand what I am saying to you Christopher?

Brother Christopher: Yes I do.

Maccello: And are you content with what we have said so far?

Brother Christopher: I'm content with what you've just said, yes certainly.

*Maccello:* Now tell me the next part of your question.

Brother Christopher: Understanding.

*Maccello:* Understanding is love, as I have just said, you have embraced all these things, without love there is no true understanding of your fellow men. I know you can read a book and understand the words, not only because you love what you are reading, you can understand many things but the gift of this understanding, whatever it is, is because you love, to a degree, that which you are seeking the understanding of and expressing the understanding of. So you see Christopher, your question once again, is really one question and there is only one answer, it is the true expression of the spirit of God within. This is love and understanding. Does this make you happy?

**Brother Christopher:** You said to start off with accepting everything, I'm sure you did not mean absolutely everything, but would it be reasonable to say that when you said charity was love, charity is giving so love is giving also.

*Maccello:* Love is a service, love is a service to others, and to serve one another is to give of yourself and this is the giving I am talking of, I am basing all this, all these things are gifts of the spirit and they are given of the spirit and they are received of the spirit. I know there are things of which you perhaps have an understanding or a brief understanding which are not good for your progression and would possibly retard your progression, but is it not a gift of love that you have an understanding of this in order to prevent you from falling into its trap and falling by the wayside? Is this not a flash of the love of God within helping you to identify right from wrong simply through understanding what is right and wrong? Is this not an attribute of love for you from God? Do you understand? Is this made you content now Christopher? **93** 

## Brother Christopher: Yes thank you Maccello.

*Maccello:* I will talk with you for a little while and I will tell you a story, I will tell you a story of one who inspires instrument for it is a story which has great meaning for those things which you seek within, it is the story of Kim Su San.

Kim Su San was a rickshaw boy and he was a very mischievous rickshaw boy and he was always in a hurry. He was always running here, running there, never stopping to think, doing many mischievous things and he was a typical boy, by coincidence, about the same age as Maccello when I left this plane. Kim Su San lived in a small Chinese province way back in the times of the Ming Dynasty (Ming Dynasty ruled China 1368-1644) and just outside this province in the mountains there was a great temple and the master of this temple Chu Ling was a good and kindly man and many times people would come to this little province and they would ask of the rickshaw boys to take them to the temple so that they may worship in the temple with the master Chu Ling and on the one occasion a visitor came and he asked Kim Su San, please to take me to the temple where I may go and worship. So Kim Su San took the man to this temple and it was at this time of the close of the day and Kim Su San journeyed into the temple and when the man had left him Kim Su San, being a mischievous boy, decided he would take a short cut across the forbidden gardens, the holy gardens of the temple, with his rickshaw and as he did so, passing a lake and some great tall floral shrubberies, he suddenly came upon the master Chu Ling and the master spoke to him and called him Kim Su San. Kim was terribly surprised and very, very frightened because here was this great master sitting in meditation under the blossoms beside a lake and one thing which astonished him most of all was that the master knew his name and he had not yet opened his eyes and yet he knew it was Kim Su San. And Kim Su San went to his side, very humbly and very frightened and the master bid him to sit beside him and trembling the boy sat quietly at his side and the master said no more, he simply sat in silence of his own inner peace.

Kim Su San, being what he was, found it very difficult to sit still for so long and he was becoming very troubled and very fidgety and he wanted to move but he dare not because he had already understood that Chu Ling could see him even though his eyes were shut. And suddenly the master spoke to him and he said to him Kim Su San, look into the heavens and tell me what you see and Kim Su San looked into the heavens and he said to him, master I can see lots and lots of stars twinkling away in the heavens but I see nothing else. And Chu Ling said to him, as above so beneath and he said to him again, look into the lake Kim Su San and tell me what you see and Kim Su San looked into the lake and he said to him, I can see the stars twinkling in the heavens in the waters and again Chu Ling say to him, as above so beneath. But Kim Su San was troubled by this and he said to him, but master why do you keep saying to me as above so beneath when above is the heaven and beneath is the Earth and the waters. Chu Ling say to him, are you not looking upon the reflection of the heavens in the waters beneath Kim Su San and he said yes master and Chu Ling said to him, Kim Su San the Earth is no different to the heavens, for there in the heavens is a great inky blackness and a vast emptiness and but for the millions of the lights which adorn the heavens as the stars in the sky bring into this great inky blackness a beauty, a mysterious beauty and depth and each one twinkling in its own way, each one is an individual, each one has its own little piece of space and here on Earth Kim Su San there are many such little planets who all twinkle in their own way and who all have their own little space. They call them human beings and you are one of those and if you allow yourself to be a good boy and do all those things which are good then your light will shine in between and cause upon this darkened Earth a little light to make it a little more beautiful and a better place to be.

And so you see this is why I say to you, as above, so beneath. And he said to Kim Su San, also I would remind you Kim Su San, when you look upon the surface of the waters to remember, the surface of the waters and the reflections there upon do not reveal its true depth and just because you in your light heartedness reflected to some an image of mischief we know that deep within you, in your true depth, there is the spirit of love. The hour is getting late Kim Su San, remember all I have said and go your way and Kim Su San remembered these things and he went his way and as the hour was growing dark and had even grown darker by now, Kim Su San was running through his province, through his little township and he must have misjudged his position and fell into the river and was taken into these realms. This is a true story of Kim Su San, it is a story we would wish you to remember and when you look into the heavens, into this vast blackness of the universe lightened up by these millions of little planets, shining, reflected by a great light, remember in your hearts that just as it is in the heavens, so it is here on Earth. There is a darkness on this Earth and such as the light and such as you, that there is a beauty added to this Earth and to its darkness by the aura of your love and understanding and whatever you may see on the surface of one another remember, as Chu Ling said, the surface of the waters do not reveal its depth and what you see on the surface of your neighbour also does not always receive and reveal its depth, for there is always a great love within seeking to be born again and you with your faith and with your love and with your understanding, these three things upon which you have dwelt this night, can be revealed to one another and to your fellow men that as above so it is beneath. You understand this? This is the story of Kim Su San and it is the story of each and every one of you, remember it when you walk in doubt and when you have fear in your hearts look into the heavens and seek your faith and know and understand that the light in the heavens is only a reflection of the light which is in your aura and in your love for your fellow men. I will leave you now to contemplate these things, I will leave you to seek an understanding, the understanding of the faith, of the hope and of love all of these from which is born understanding. I would say only this in addition to those things you have already received and done and practised.

And so we say be mindful always of your inner cleanliness, be mindful of the cleanliness and the interpretations of those things you speak, let thine eye be single and filled with the purity of light, let your mouths be the mouth of an angel, filled with the purity of his love and the teaching and philosophy of his grace and let your heart be filled with the purity of being, the purity of the divine grace within which is of the spirit of God. Therefore my children I say in love, cleanse yourselves, prepare your spirit, prepare your understanding and your way of life to those of a divine creation and a divine grace and a divine purpose, a divine course and walk in purity and peace, in love, in faith, in hope. I reverse these things as you may think more clearly of them for they are too easily said in their true sequence and so easily forgotten. Having said these things my children shall we now pray to the Father and ask his grace.

O Lord who desirest not the death of a sinner but that he experiences eternal life, we know and love and trust O Father that we as sinners here on Earth come before thee in love and trust and in human faith and hope that you will receive us and know us for what we are and that you will cleanse us and bless us and receive us into thy service and keep within our hearts thine eternal peace and purpose that thy faith may remain whole and that our love shall prosper and grow and that our eternal hope in thee shall be made manifest in those things we reveal to our brother men. Father we bless and praise the head of our Brother John bless him in his dedication and service and reveal to him in thy good grace his true cause on Earth. Bring him closer to our fold; bring him closer to the love and the grace of those who inspire him. To all these children Father, bring unto them thine eternal gift of life and revelation of truth and peace and the purification of the spirit, the mind and of the body that they may be true bright shining lights here on Earth, lighting the pathway for those who are so blind they will not see and for those who are so deaf they will not hear, for those who are so dumb they will not speak and yet O Father, affliction has not touched them. May the peace and the love of God and the truth and the grace of his son Jesus Christ our Lord, who in the spirit of the one true living God, revealed to mankind peace and joy in the spirit of Christ.
