The Meaning of Christmas - The Resurrection of Man - The Title and Foreword of The Book.

Maccello: God bless you.

All: God bless you Maccello.

Maccello: What a privilege it is for Maccello to come once again to share these few moments with you and to help you in your moments of indecision and to remind you that what we are doing together is a labour of love and is for Maccello a supreme privilege to be permitted to come forward and unfold these teachings for you and to answer those things, which are not in my heart but are in your hearts and therefore must be in the hearts of so many of your brothers and sisters here in this plane and for us to share these moments of truth for the first time, even before your fellow men will receive them. I want you to consider just what it is you are embarking on, it's not just a project of a spiritual awareness, it is a labour of God. You are, as it were, chosen to convey this re-enlightened version of Christian truth to mankind according to his understanding today, not of yesterday nor of tomorrow, but of today. And so it is important that every word you can use should be used, every teaching you are given should be taught and every truth should be permitted to become a truth and not just a hope or a wish or a dream, it must become a reality in order to fulfil its objective and its purpose. You understand this; you understand what I am saying to you? It's so very important and each one of you has a blessed task to perform and we are well pleased with the performance of your tasks at this time and we don't want any distortions or diversions of the truth brought into these teachings at any time for whatever reason. Do you understand this now?

Brother John: Yes I do.

Maccello: We will call this works Daybreak, because you see daybreak is as life itself, it is a continuous and eternal manifestation here on Earth. It is an eternal thing; it is happening every second of the day, every day of the week, every week of the year. It is something which is unceasing, so also is life and these words Brother John you will write in the beginning of the pages of this book.

Brother John: I think that is magnificent Maccello, God bless you. Beautiful.

Maccello: And again they will not be diversified from in any way and it will also be pointed out to your fellow men that as truly as each day is born life continues, there is a new day born every moment, there is a new child born at the same time. There is a new life coming upon this Earth and with a new life there is coming a new understanding, a new truth, a new way of life, a new awareness, a new vision of God and we do not want this vision of God to become tarnished by the old concepts of man, but we want it to be polished and to shine among men by the realization that man has of him this day and in this age. We are not looking at one religion as opposed to another; we are embracing all of them, it is time now when man must come together and identify with God for what God is. All over the world now it is coming about where different religions, denominations and creeds are coming together and they are being brought together by the very act of man himself, man with his machines has made this Earth a very small place to be in and all your different cultures, different nationalities, different communities, different languages, different ways of life are coming together now and many there are from different walks of life, different colours and creeds and different nations who live here in this small island as brothers and sisters, as one, inter-born with one another, inter-related and with this coming is coming

the greater understanding of the love of God because these new generations which are coming up from this are going to say, but I love my fellow men in the same way as he does and yet he's a different colour from me. This makes no difference; you are all Children of God and Brother John, when you compose these words in the chapters of Daybreak we will ask that you will bring this to the fore, that man must live with man whatever denomination, colour or creed, that man must live side by side with his brother and sister and come to know him and love him and accept him as a Child of God. Where else otherwise will you find a true concept of the brotherhood of man if one nation will not accept another because of its denomination, of its creed, of its colour, of its faith or of its standing among the nations of this world. There is a great universal love being born here on this Earth right under your very noses and as one nation comes together with another and as one culture comes into the understanding of another and they share each others beliefs and ways of life and accept each other for what they are, then the love of God is becoming manifest within their being and it is showing itself once again across this world of yours to be the truth that it is, one hope, one faith, one love, one God. This is the ultimate dream, this is the ultimate goal, this is mans ultimate task, to become one with himself and one another and with his God and it is our prayerful wish that the words we have given you to enter into the chapters, under this heading of Daybreak, will unfold to man something of these truths and will lighten the pathway for them to find their peace, to find their God and to know their brother and their sister as true brothers and sisters and so bring a stop to all this turmoil and jealousy and killing and hate.

This is the dream of God; this is his purpose among men, that this universe of yours, this universal love shall touch the hearts of all men, beginning with the chapters of Daybreak and others like it to follow.

Is this make you happy Brother John?

Brother John: Yes that's beautiful. The title of the book is very, very beautiful.

Maccello: Is there anything you wish to ask Maccello now?

Brother John: No, are you asking me to begin the teaching session now Maccello?

Maccello: Which ever you choose.

Brother John: Well I've got no comment to make on anything previous unless any other member has: I think it's beautiful.

Maccello: Is for them an opportunity to speak.

Brother John: I think we are unanimous Maccello in thanking you and you make us feel very humble and I'm sure everyone here will pledge themselves both fully and faithfully to Gods service. So now Maccello I would like to ask you, what is the real meaning of Christmas?

Maccello: Ah, Christmas. Have we not just been talking about Christmas Brother John?

Brother John: We have indeed.

Maccello: Have we not been talking about Daybreak?

Brother John: We have indeed.

Maccello: And a new birth, a new beginning, a new joy upon the Earth, a joy of realization of the love of God.

It was as it was intended to be, a moment when man was suddenly made to stand still and think about this miracle of birth. So often it had happened, so often it had been taken for granted, so often these little ones had been used for slaughter when the first-born were taken and slain. And in so many other occasions when little ones were sacrificed on the altar, on this table of God, man in his barbaric way, in his blindness, could actually take a little infant child of God and lay him on this high alter of his, of which we spoke of before Brother John and slaughtered it in the name of God. And so you see, Christ was born to make man understand that God did not wish the destruction of life to please him, he wanted the creation of life to over joy him. He did not want his high alter used as a table of slaughter and offering, the only thing he wanted offered from this table was the offerings of love and self sacrifice, one towards another, self sacrifice not in life and death but in worship, in faith, in charity one towards another. And here we have the story of Christmas when this spirit of love was born here on this plane and made men stop, from the lowly to the mighty, even the creatures of the Earth, everything stood still, there was not a movement and man suddenly come to realise, this is a life and this little life has brought something with it we have not identified with before. What is it, what is this strange feeling that we feel within our hearts towards this little one, and oddly enough that we are beginning to feel one towards another, even towards the creatures who have given their bed for this child, what is this feeling? What is this new understanding, this new awareness, this love, we will call it love and it is the love of God, is life and life is love, life is born of love, it's born of the coming together of two spirits in harmony one with the other and creating between them the infant of love.

There in their hands is this tiny manifestation of God and so is why I say to you, every day, every day every minute of the day is Christmas, it's the Christ mass, the mass coming of Christ, Christendom, of a way of life, away of loving, a way of living, a way of being, a way of understanding, a way of truth for man. And this Brother John is how Maccello will see Christmas day every day of your life but we know that man has taken this joyous moment when this particular child was born, he has made much more of it than it was because of his state of awareness at the time, he was very imaginative and they had a very mysterious way of thinking and much of their living was based on mysticism but it wasn't a mystical thing and it wasn't the truth. And so it was steeped in mysticism, this simple birth, but it is a mysticism that only man has created for himself. But the great miracle of this came when Christ began to reveal himself for what he truly was, a perfect example of man, a perfect being, a man who was able to walk into the wilderness knowing of the gifts he had, knowing of the power he had over man because of mans simple way of life and this magnificent understanding that he had of love and the power of love and a gift of an ultimate faith, an immovable faith and trust in God. Was he going to take these gifts and use them for himself, was he going to listen to the temptations of his own material being and use them to enrichen himself, take from this Earth all the things he could have done or was he going to go forward, accepting his life as a simple being and dedicate his life to becoming a living example of the love of God and all that the love of God is in man. And this he chose to do and so it was when he returned from the wilderness the Father said to the multitudes, this is my beloved son in whom I am well pleased and it was for these reasons he was well pleased, he had forsaken self and ordained his life to the love of God.

And so it is today Brother John, many will condemn and harm and deprave a child and walk away and think to themselves, I have not been found out, this may be true as far as a man is concerned but the Lord our God is an all seeing God, he is an all knowing God, need I say more Brother John?

Brother John: No.

Maccello: So you see, I know it's a long, long way to tell you this, but Christmas day Brother John is every day of your life, every minute of every day of your life, every time a child is born so is Christmas but all this is because of the coming of Christ and of the Christ consciousness among men, born to heal, born to bless, born to love, born to forgive, born to create among men a new way of life. Is this make you happy Brother John?

Brother John: Very fine Maccello, thank you.

Maccello: What else will you talk with Maccello of now?

Brother John: The conception was by the power of the Holy Spirit not by the sperm of Joseph.

Maccello: The conception of the spirit of Christ was born in the heart of God and placed in the hearts of men. You understand this Brother John?

Brother John: Yes I understand it.

Maccello: So I have said to you this was ordained that the Christ contentiousness should come upon this Earth in order to transform a man from his evil ways and to enlighten him and to bring about into his awareness this new understanding, this new feeling, this new experience we call life or love. Man, as I have said, at this time was very superstitious and was very easily impressed and easily led and whose life and the events of their lives revolved around superstitions and mystical beliefs. These are for men to come to terms with; the truth of the birth of Christ is simply this, that God moved the spirit of Christ onto this Earth so that the spirit of love should be born and this was indeed a virgin birth, but man and his mysticism has created it into many other things for which we are not responsible. You understand this Brother John? Man will be what man is and this is why we want to bring for you a new beginning, a new awareness and polish up this truth and these philosophies of life, make them shine again in the hearts of men so they can have a truer understanding and yet, at the same time Brother John, taking greater care not to destroy this beautiful story which has been passed down from age to age and the miracle which it brings with it of love and giving and prayer and a coming together of mankind. Anything which creates this in the hearts of men must not be disturbed nor distorted nor destroyed, but enhanced, but in truth. Is this make you happy Brother John?

Brother John: Yes thank you Maccello.

Maccello: And so now are you content?

Brother John: Who were the Magi, what was their purpose?

Maccello: These again were the Priests of old time. These were those who I suppose you would say are as instrument is, men of the spirit, men who could give themselves to the spirit and receive the wisdom of the spirit and allowed these things to be said, unfortunately they were not believed. And so it is today, still man cannot comprehend this completely in his heart but yet it is true to say also it is the truth, which is becoming wider and wider known and will become so many years from now. But we will begin the story now Brother John and we will continue on with those of this sensitive creed of beings began and still continue to perform the laws of God and to make them manifest in the hearts of men through the deeper inner vision with which they are blessed. Is this make you happy now Brother John?

Brother John: Yes thank you.

Maccello: Since this is last time for a little time who else now will talk with Maccello and give Brother John a much needed rest? No one will talk with Maccello?

Sister Valerie: Maccello, could you tell us of the significance of the gifts of the three Magi of frankincense, gold and myrrh, what did they...

Maccello: The gifts of frankincense, gold and myrrh, this I do not understand and I have tried often to understand this but they were material gifts which were being brought, I suppose, as was the custom in this time as offerings for various reasons of their own, but Maccello is first to confess, I in my simple way have no understanding of their true meanings and true conceptions of this. Gold is symbolic of those material riches of the Earth is also symbolic in the radiance in colour of the higher and spiritual awareness of those rays which are shaped in the aura of man and so reflect his spirituality. Incense, frankincense if you wish, I can only think in my simple way in my heart Sister Valerie, that by doing this he was purifying the air, perhaps he thought the cattle sheds smelt of dung too much, I don't know, I would not suppose this at all but it is symbolic of the purification of all those things around him, the air he breathes and of his being and of the cleansing of his aura and inner being. The myrrh was really to anoint the child, to bless his body with this gentle smelling ointment just as Christ was anointed on his feet.

I don't know, I don't know, I really could not say, yes Sister Valerie this is definitely the reason why but these are the reasons why I would suspect. You see, man was such an odd individual in them times and he had so many strange ways about him and this is a sort of a carnal way of being that they were, everything they touched which they thought was sacred had to be touched with this, this anointing and had to be treated with scented oils and had to be blessed and gifted with the wealth of the Earth. This was their way and there could have been so many, many reasons why and I would not be fool enough to say it was for this reason or for that but I would suppose it was for those reasons I have explained to you. Is this make you content?

Sister Valerie: Thank you, yes.

Maccello: I can only be true to you in my heart Sister Valerie; I will not create suppositions to content your mind and I will not take advantage of this higher awareness, which we have over the awareness of your material man and say this was so. I will leave it for your own understanding and for you to come to terms with in your own heart if Maccello has given you a true theory on this, one which contents you then so be, it's really of no matter. You understand this my child?

Sister Valerie: Yes thank you. 158

Maccello: Who else now will talk with Maccello, not my little Sister Jacqueline, it's a long time since I heard your voice?

Sister Jacqueline: Good evening Maccello.

Maccello: Now you have made my heart sink. Is there anything you would wish to ask Maccello?

Sister Jacqueline: No I don't think there is Maccello I'm afraid.

Maccello: Always there is this loving contentment in your heart, which Maccello so loves so much. I get so excited when I think of it and when I know you are present among us I feel so content knowing you are here as a little inspiration of love and tranquillity and stillness and peace. It's a beautiful gift you have; treasure it all the days of your life even if it means you speak not a word. Love is so much more purer when it comes from the heart, radiates from the aura and touches others unblemished by words. You understand this Sister Jacqueline?

Sister Jacqueline: Yes I do Maccello, thank you.

Maccello: And what of my Brother Christopher?

Brother Christopher: I have a feeling what I was thinking of asking you we've already

asked Maccello.

Maccello: Then ask Maccello again.

Brother Christopher: Did we ask about the resurrection John?

Brother John: Not to my recollection.

Brother Christopher: No, in the past have we?

Brother John: Yes.

Brother Christopher: We have, yes I thought we had.

Maccello: We have spoken of this Brother Christopher. What of this does trouble you?

Brother Christopher: No it was just the thought of Christmas and what followed it. At Easter sort of thing you know.

Maccello: Brother Christopher, it's interesting you should say this because you see, although with Christmas we celebrate the birth of Christ we also celebrate a resurrection, because you see we celebrate the resurrection of man. Is there anymore you wish to ask me of this Brother Christopher. I answered this for you content...

Brother Christopher: That's very, very interesting thank you.

Maccello: and all of you now are content. Is there anything you wish for me to tell you of this instructions we have given you, I want to be sure now before I leave you that there is nothing in your hearts which will cause you to conflict with one another and to cause upset and heartbreak among you. I want you to know and understand one another's purpose and cause so you can work in harmony with one another, assisting one another, gently and in love and in good faith and in goodwill and in the true spirit of God. Is you understand this? So, be at peace with one another, love one another and work with

Maccello and Brother Gustus Emmanuel that we may bring about for you now, a purpose in life, a cause, a truth, a beginning, another Christmas. So it is end now, I will take my leave of you but I shall walk with you all the time and you only have to call Maccello and I will come to you and I will be at your side Brother John...

Maccello: Is this make you content?

Brother John: I look forward to it yes Maccello.

Maccello: So when you celebrate your Christmas Brother John, shed your tears with joy. God bless you all and may Maccello say, may the true spirit of Christmas rest in your hearts and in your homes and may the spirit of Christmas love remain with you always throughout your lives and may the same spirit of love which was born on that day be reborn again in your hearts and into your lives at the joy of love and of giving, not necessarily of material gifts, but of the gifts of the spirit shall remain with you always as a gift of the love of God. God bless.

Gustus: God bless you my children.

All: God bless you Gustus.

Gustus: So it is my children you now stand on the threshold of a new way of life and it is for you to look into your hearts and know yourselves as you truly are, to shed away those things of the material plane as a butterfly will shed away its chrysalis and adorn the Earth with its beauty. So we see you shedding away those things of the material life, which are of no consequence to your spiritual growth, that you may also spread those wings of love contained within your aura, touch the Earth and the hearts of mankind with the love of your being, the gentleness of your grace, the truth of your purpose. And soon we come upon this moment, the advent of the birth of man, the advent of the coming of Christ, the advent of the coming of love, the advent of the coming of God into the hearts of men.
