Blessed with profound empathy, unwavering commitment and unshakable faith since young, she turned her back to the worldly pleasures and focussed on serving the mankind ever since she was 18. After years of service as a teacher and mentor, Mother Teresa experienced a call within her religious call, which changed her course of life completely, making her what she is known as today. Founder of the Missionaries of Charity, with her fervent commitment and incredible organizational and managerial skills, she developed an international organization that aimed towards helping the impoverished. Mother Teresa passed over on September 5, 1997 in Kolkata, For her service to humanity she was honoured with the Nobel Peace Prize in 1979 and was canonised by Pope Francis on 4 September 2016.
